

ORDINANCE NO. 1312

TO VACATE CERTAIN ALLEYS IN COLLEGE HILL PLACE
SUBDIVISION AND COLLEGE HILL PLACE ANNEX
SUBDIVISION

WHEREAS, In the opinion of the Commission of the City of Upper Arlington, Ohio, there is good cause for vacating the alleys hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, Such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest, and should be made, now, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commission of the City of Upper Arlington, Ohio:

Section 1. That all the alleys in College Hill Place Subdivision and College Hill Place Annex Subdivision, in the City of Upper Arlington, Ohio, except the first alley north of Lane Avenue, running parallel to Lane Avenue, be and the same hereby are vacated, provided, however, that the wires, lines, pipes and poles of the City of Upper Arlington and of the public utility companies operating in said City, now in place in said alleys shall be maintained in place, and the owners thereof and the City of Upper Arlington shall have the right of ingress and egress, and to replace, repair and maintain said facilities and shall have easements therein and the right to install and maintain any further wires, lines, pipes and poles which may be necessary to adequately serve the City and the inhabitants thereof.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
