

ORDINANCE NO. 14-61

TO VACATE AN EASEMENT ON LOT 1, BLOCK 3,  
MIDDLESEX PLACE ADDITION

WHEREAS there presently exists an easement for sewers and other public utility purposes, 10 feet in width, extending in a north and south direction across the westerly end of Lot No. 1, Block No. 3, of Middlesex Place Addition as shown of record in Plat Book 7, page 32, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the owner of said lot is desirous of having said easement abandoned, and

WHEREAS, said easement is not now used for any utility purpose, and it appears that it will not be needed in the future for such purposes, all utility lines necessary to service the area having been installed in other locations, and

WHEREAS, the Council is satisfied that there is good cause for the abandonment of such easement, and that such abandonment will not be detrimental to the general public; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Upper Arlington, Ohio:

Section 1. That the above described easement and right-of-way be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest dated allowed by law.
