## ORDINANCE NO. 17-56

TO ACCEPT A DEED TO THE CITY OF UPPER  
ARLINGTON AND TO DEDICATE THE PREMISES  
THEREIN DESCRIBED FOR STREET PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commission of the City of Upper Arlington, Ohio, three-fourths or more of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the deed from Paul Decker Realty, Inc. to the City of Upper Arlington, Ohio, dated October 27, 1955, filed for record with the Recorder of Franklin County, Ohio, November 1, 1955 and recorded in Deed Book 1920 at page 211, be and it hereby is accepted and the premises so conveyed are hereby dedicated to public use for street purposes, as set forth in said deed, said premises constituting an extension of and to be known as, Surrey Hill Place.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


