ORDINANCE NO. 237-28

To vacate all that part of Grenoble Road extending from Coventry Road to Andover Road, in the Village of Upper Arlington, Ohio.

WHEREAS, on the 20 day of March, 1928, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of and abutting upon that portion of Grenoble Road extending from Coventry Road to Andover Road, in the Village of Upper Arlington, Ohio, was duly presented to the Commissioners of the Village of Upper Arlington, Ohio, praying that said Grenoble Road, between the points named, be vacated and there is filed with the Commissioners the written consent to such vacation by the owners of all of the property abutting upon that part of Grenoble Road described; and

WHEREAS, that portion of Grenoble Road between the points named is no longer of use to the public and its vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the Village of Upper Arlington, Ohio:

Section 1. That the portion of Grenoble Road extending from Coventry Road to Andover Road be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
