ORDINANCE NO. 471

TO VACATE THE FOUR ALLEYS LYING IN
COLLEGE HILL SUBDIVISION IN THE
VILLAGE OF UPPER ARLINGTON SUBJECT
TO RESERVATION FOR PUBLIC UTILITY
PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on the third day of August, 1937, a petition
by all persons owning property abutting upon the four alleys
contained in the plat of College Hill Subdivision, was duly
presented to the Commission, consenting and praying that said
alleys be vacated; and

WHEREAS, this Commission, upon hearing, is satisfied
that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that
it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought
to be made:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Commission of
the Village of Upper Arlington, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the four alleys lying in College
Hill Subdivision of this Village, described as follows:

1. The alley running in a generally easterly
and westerly direction from Elmwood Road to the
east corporation line of said Village, about 170
feet north of Lane Avenue.

2. The alley running in a generally easterly
and westerly direction from Elmwood Road to the east

corporation line of said Village, lying immediately north of Wilshire Drive (if said Wilshire Drive were continued through to east corporation line) and about half way between Lane Avenue and the north corporation line.

X 3. The alley running in a generally northerly and southerly direction, lying between Elmwood Road and Westmont Boulevard.

X 4. The alley running in a generally northerly and southerly direction, east of Westmont Boulevard and along the east corporation line,

be and they hereby are vacated, subject, however, to a reservation and easement for all public utility purposes, to wit; water lines and pipe, gas lines and pipe, electric poles, wires and appliances, telephones poles, wires and appliances and any and all other public utilities, poles, wires, pipes and instrumentalities of every kind and character, together with the right of ingress and egress to lay, remove, replace, repair and maintain.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
