ORDINANCE NO. 6-73

TO CHANGE THE NAME OF WYANDOTTE AVENUE TO WYANDOTTE ROAD

WHEREAS, Wyandotte Avenue, in this City, is an extension of the street known as Wyandotte Road in the cities of Columbus and Grandview Heights, and

WHEREAS, there is a street in the City of Columbus known as Wyandotte Avenue, which does not connect with Wyandotte Avenue in the City of Upper Arlington and is at a considerable distance therefrom, and

WHEREAS, Wyandotte Avenue in this City is generally known to the public as Wyandotte Road, and is so designated in the United States Postal Service Zip Code Directory and the Columbus Telephone Directory, and

WHEREAS, a written request has been made by a resident of this City to change the name of Wyandotte Avenue to Wyandotte Road,

NOW, THEREFORE, in order to avoid confusion between Wyandotte Avenue in Upper Arlington and Wyandotte Avenue in Columbus, and to conform the name of said street to that by which it is customarily known,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UPPER ARLINGTON, OHIO:

Section 1. That the name of the street now known as Wyandotte Avenue be and the same is hereby changed to Wyandotte Road.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
