

ORDINANCE NO. 81-60

TO VACATE THE ALLEY EAST OF RIVERSIDE DRIVE,
EXTENDING SOUTHERLY FROM WICKLIFFE ROAD TO
EASTLEFT DRIVE

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of this City has presented to City Council its recommendation that the first alley east of Riverside Drive, extending in a north and south direction, be vacated from Wickliffe Road to Eastleft Drive, and

WHEREAS, notice of the pendency of said proposal and of the hearing thereon has been given as provided by law, and

WHEREAS, the Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as proposed, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Upper Arlington, Ohio, three-fourths or more of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the first alley east of Riverside Drive, extending in a north and south direction from Wickliffe Road to Eastleft Drive, be and the same is hereby vacated, provided, however, that the wires, lines, pipes and poles of the City of Upper Arlington and of the public utility companies operating in said City, now in place in said street shall be maintained in place, and the owners thereof and the City of Upper Arlington, its assigns and licensees, shall have the right of ingress and egress to replace, repair and maintain said facilities and shall have easements therein and the right to install and maintain any further wires, lines, pipes, poles and drains which may be necessary to adequately service the City and the inhabitants thereof.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
