

ORDINANCE NO. 1000-53

TO VACATE CERTAIN ALLEYS IN THE LLEWELLYN
PARK ADDITION OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE,
OHIO, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of October, 1953, a petition by the person owning lots and property adjacent to certain alleys in the Llewellyn Park Addition as hereinafter set forth was duly presented to Council praying that said alleys named be vacated,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the 20 foot alley adjacent to Lots Nos. 46, 72, 73, 74, 75, 76 and 100 of Llewellyn Park Addition, said alley running south from East Park Street on the east boundary of the lots mentioned, be and the same is vacated.

Section 2. That the 20 foot alley adjacent to Lots Nos. 43, 44, 45, 46 and 72, said alley running easterly from Llewellyn Avenue to an alley on the east boundary of said Lots 46 and 72, be and the same is vacated.

Section 3. That the 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ foot alley adjacent to Lots Nos. 97, 98, 99, 100 and 117, said alley running easterly from Llewellyn Avenue to an alley on the east boundary of Lot No. 100 be and the same is vacated.

Section 4. That the Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 5. That this ordinance ~~shall take effect from and after its passage~~ ^{is hereby declared to be an} emergency and shall take effect from and after its passage.
