

ORDINANCE NO. 1050 - 55

TO VACATE FAIRVIEW AVENUE BETWEEN HIAWATHA AND CENTRAL AVENUES.

WHEREAS, on the 29th day of June, 1955, a petition by persons owning all of the lots abutting Fairview Avenue between Hiawatha and Central Avenues in the Hiawatha Park Addition as hereinafter described was duly presented praying that said street be vacated and,

WHEREAS, a hearing before the Planning Commission of the Village of Westerville was held on the 1st day of June, 1955, and there was found to be good cause for such vacation and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and should be made,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following street in Hiawatha Park Addition be and the same is vacated:

Fairview Avenue extending from the south line of Hiawatha Avenue southward and southwestward to the north line of Central Avenue as extended between the points of the beginning of the curve in the southwest corner of Lot 29 and the beginning of the curve in the southeast corner of Lot 31, being 50 feet in width and approximately 300 feet in length.

Section 2. That the Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
