

ORDINANCE NO. 1079

TO VACATE CERTAIN SECTIONS OF AN ALLEY IN THE LLEWELLYN PARK ADDITION.

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of April 1956, a petition by the majority of persons owning lots abutting the alley at the north side of the Llewellyn Park Addition as hereinafter described was duly presented praying that said alley be vacated and,

WHEREAS, a hearing before the Planning Commission of the Village of Westerville was held on the 24th day of April, 1956, and there was found to be good cause for such vacation and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and should be made,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following sections of an alley be and the same are vacated:

Two sections of the 16.5 foot alley along the north side of the Llewellyn Park Addition between the following described boundaries:

Parcel I: Beginning at the east right-of-way line of Otterbein Avenue extended southerly across said alley; thence easterly to the east line of Lot No. 11 of Llewellyn Park Addition, extended northerly across said alley.

Parcel II: Beginning at the west line of Lot No. 12 of Llewellyn Park Addition extended northerly across said alley; thence easterly to the east line of Lot No. 22 of Llewellyn Park Addition extended northerly across said alley.

Section 2. That the Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
