

ORDINANCE NO. 1087-56

TO VACATE CERTAIN ALLEYS IN THE LLEWELLYN PARK ADDITION.

WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of October 1956, petitions by the persons owning all the lots adjacent to certain alleys in the Llewellyn Park Addition as hereinafter set forth were duly presented to Council praying that said alleys be vacated and,

WHEREAS, hearings on such petitions were held on the 30th day of October 1956, and this Council finds that there is good cause for such vacation and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and should be made,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following alleys in the Llewellyn Park Addition be and the same are vacated:

- a. The east and west alley between Linabary Avenue and Llewellyn Avenue whose center line at the intersection with the center line of Linabary Avenue is approximately 310 feet north of the center line of Walnut Street and running eastwardly to Llewellyn Avenue a distance of approximately 340 feet, and being 16.5 feet in width.
- b. The north and south alley between Linabary Avenue and Llewellyn Avenue whose center line is approximately 195 feet east of the center line of Linabary Avenue and parallel thereto, being approximately 217 feet in length and 20 feet in width.

Section 2. That the Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
