

Resolution.

Be it resolved by the Council of the incorporated village of Westerville, Ohio, that hereafter no petition or request for the construction of any sewer other than a general main sewer, will be granted unless such petition or request be in writing and be signed by a majority of the owners of property benefited by the proposed improvement, And no such petition shall be granted or such improvement be ordered by this Council unless such petition ask that at least one-half of the total cost of such improvement be assessed on the abutting and adjacent and contiguous lots and lands in said village in proportion to the benefit which will result from said improvement.

An Ordinance To accept dedication of land for continuing Summit Street.

Whereas Charles Watson and Lucy Watson his wife have by warranty deed dated Nov. 4, 1895, conveyed to the village of Westerville Ohio, certain real estate therein described, and dedicated the same for a continuance of Summit street from its terminus between Main and Park streets to Park street, Therefore be it
