

ORDINANCE No. 235 - 1909

TO VACATE the ALLEY extending along the south side of lots 8, 9, 10 & 11, and along the west side of said lot 11, all in William Sharp's Addition.

WHEREAS on the 20th day of August, 1909, a petition signed by Virgil L. Weakly, owning all the lots and abutting both sides of a certain alley 16½ feet wide and extending along the south side of lots 8, 9, 10 & 11 and along the west side of said lot 11, all in William Sharp's Addition to the Village of Westerville, was duly presented to the Council, praying, among other things for the vacation of said alley above mentioned, and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interests, and ought to be granted, now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Westerville, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the alley extending along the south sides of lots 8, 9, 10 & 11, and along the west side of lot 11, all in William Sharp's Addition to the Village of Westerville, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
