

hibited within the following square, bounded as follows: On the North by West Home Street or East Home Street extended East, on the East by the first alley east of State Street, on the South by Winter Street, on the West by Knox Street.

SECTION 2. That any building or buildings or additions to any building erected contrary to the provisions of this ordinance shall, after 30 days notice to the owner to remove the same, be removed by the fire chief and the expense of such removal charged to the owner.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

ORDINANCE No. 317.

DECLARING a PUBLIC HIGHWAY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Westerville,
State of Ohio:

That the following described property, viz., A strip fifty (50) feet wide off the north side of the present disposal plant, from the east line of said property to the east line of Knox Street produced southerly, be and the same is hereby declared a Public Highway.
