

ATTACHED, AS THEY RESPECTIVELY MATURE. SAID BOND SHALL EXPRESS UPON ITS FACE THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH IT WAS ISSUED AND THAT IT WAS ISSUED IN PURSUANCE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

SECTION IV: THAT SAID BOND TOGETHER WITH INTEREST COUPONS, SHALL BE ISSUED AND SIGNED ACCORDING TO LAW.

SECTION V: THAT THE FAITH AND REVENUE OF ALL THE REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN SAID VILLAGE IS HEREBY PLEDGED TO THE PAYMENT OF SAID BOND AND COUPONS, ACCORDING TO THE TERMS THEREOF.

SECTION VI: THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE SHALL LEVY A TAX IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER TAXES AUTHORIZED BY LAW, TO PAY SAID BOND AND INTEREST THEREON, AS THE SAME BECOME DUE AND PAYABLE, AND THAT THERE IS HEREBY LEVIED AND ASSESSED ANNUALLY ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE SAID VILLAGE AN AMOUNT SUFFICIENT TO PAY SAID BOND, TOGETHER WITH THE INTEREST COUPONS, AT MATURITY, AS PROVIDED FOR HEREIN.

SECTION VII: THAT THE CLERK OF THE COUNCIL IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DIRECTED TO DELIVER TO THE AUDITOR OF THE COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF OHIO, A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE AS PROVIDED BY SECTION 5649-18, G. C. O. YEAR BOOK 109, PAGE 344.

SECTION VIII: SAID BOND SHALL BE OFFERED FOR SALE AT PAR AND ACCRUED INTEREST AS PROVIDED BY LAW, AND THE PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF SAID BOND, EXCEPT THE PREMIUM AND ACCRUED INTEREST THEREON, SHALL BE USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE INDEBTEDNESS AFORESAID, AND FOR NO OTHER PURPOSE.

SECTION IX: THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW.

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ORDINANCE NO. 471.

TO ACCEPT THE PLAT OF JOHN LIGHTNER SUBDIVIDING THIRTY AND FIVE HUNDRETHS (30.05) ACRES OF LAND.

WHEREAS: ON THE 10TH DAY OF APRIL, 1903, GARRY W. MEEKER, THEN OWNER OF THIRTY AND FIVE HUNDRETHS (30.05) ACRES OF LAND, SITUATED IN QUARTER TOWNSHIP NO. 2, TOWNSHIP NO. 12, RANGE NO. 17, UNITED STATES MILITARY LANDS, A PART OF WHICH LIES WITHIN THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE AND A PART LYING IN AND BEING A PART OF BLENDON TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO, PLATTED SAME INTO LOTS, DEDICATING CERTAIN STREETS AND ALLEYS AS SHOWN ON SAID PLAT, TO PUBLIC USE FOREVER, AND

WHEREAS: ON THE NINTH DAY OF APRIL, 1903, SAID PLAT WAS APPROVED BY WALTER BRAUN, COUNTY SURVEYOR, AND

WHEREAS: ON THE NINTH DAY OF APRIL, 1903, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO, APPROVED AND ACCEPTED SAID PLAT,

WHEREAS: ON THE 10TH DAY OF APRIL, 1903, THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE, BY ORDINANCE ACCEPTED SAID PLAT, AND

WHEREAS: ON THE ELEVENTH DAY OF APRIL, 1903, SAID PLAT WAS

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TRANSFERRED ON THE DUPLICATE OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO, AND
WHEREAS: ON THE SAME DAY, SAID PLAT WAS RECORDED IN
PLAT BOOK NO. 6, PAGE 14A, AND

WHEREAS: ON THE EIGHTH DAY OF JULY, 1907, BY ACTION OF
THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO, ALL OF THE LOTS
IN SAID ADDITION WERE VACATED EXCEPT THAT PORTION LYING WITHIN
THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE, AND

WHEREAS: JOHN LIGHTNER IS THE OWNER IN FEE SIMPLE OF
ALL OF THE PREMISES CONSTITUTING THE SUBDIVISION AS PER THE PLAT
OF 1903, AND

WHEREAS: THE SAID JOHN LIGHTNER HAS REPLATTED SAID PREM-
ISES, ON THE FIFTH DAY OF AUGUST, 1922, THE REPLATTING BEING AN EX-
ACT DUPLICATE OF THE PLAT OF 1903;

NO THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VIL-
LAGE OF WESTERVILLE,

SECTION I: THAT BY REASON OF THE AFORESAID STATED FACTS
THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE DOES HEREBY ACCEPT THE
PLAT OF JOHN LIGHTNER SUBDIVIDING PREMISES DESCRIBED ABOVE, AND
DOES HEREBY RATIFY AND CONFIRM SAID PLAT AND ACCEPT THE DEDICATION
OF THE STREETS AND ALLEYS INsofar AS IT AFFECTS THE PREMISES WITH-
IN THE INCORPORATED LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE, AND AP-
PROVES AND ACCEPTS THE PLAT GENERALLY.

SECTION II: THE CLERK OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE IS
HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO CERTIFY SAID ACCEPTANCE ON SAID
PLAT.

SECTION III: THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN
FORCE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED
BY LAW.

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ORDINANCE NO. 472.

TO BORROW THE SUM OF FIFTEEN HUNDRED (1500.00) DOLLARS
AND ISSUE A NOTE OR CERTIFICATE OF INDEBTEDNESS THEREFOR, IN AN-
TICIPATION OF THE REVENUE DERIVED FROM THE COLLECTIONS OF THE
WATER AND LIGHT PLANTS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING EXTENSIONS OF
THE WATER AND LIGHT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS: THE WATER AND LIGHT UTILITY HAVE A SURPLUS
OVER AND ABOVE THE EXPENSES OF CONDUCTING AND MANAGING THE WATER
WORKS SUFFICIENT TO MAKE CERTAIN EXTENSIONS, AND WHEREAS THE COUN-
CIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE, DESIRES TO EXTEND THE SEWER AND
WATER EXTENSION ON CENTER STREET AND HAVILTON AVENUE, IN THE VIL-
LAGE OF WESTERVILLE, AND WHEREAS, IN ORDER TO FINANCE AFORESAID EX-
TENSIONS IMMEDIATELY, IT IS NECESSARY TO ANTICIPATE THE REVENUES
FOR THE ENSUING SIX MONTHS, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTER-
VILLE, STATE OF OHIO.

SECTION I: THAT IN ANTICIPATION OF THE REVENUE DERIVED
