ORDINANCE NO. 476-23

D VACATE the alley extending north from West Broadway to the west line of Lot No. 15 of William Sharp's Addition.

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of July, 1922, a petition signed by all of the owners of property abutting upon the alley extending from the north line of West Broadway along the west side of Lot No. 15 of William Sharp's Addition to the north line of Lot No. 15 projected westerly was duly presented to Council praying that said alley between the points named be vacated.

WHEREAS, it appears to Council that the owners of all the property abutting upon said alley have consented to and petitioned for the vacation of said alley and that publication of notices of such petition is unnecessary under the provisions of Section 3727 of the General Code of Ohio, and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Westerville, Ohio:

Section 1. That all that portion of the alley located along the west side of Lot No. 15 of said William Sharp's Addition extending between the north line of Broadway and the north line of Lot No. 15 projected westerly be and the same is vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
