

ORDINANCE NO. 598 -27

TO VACATE PLUM STREET FROM THE WEST LINE
OF SUMMIT STREET TO THE EAST LINE OF THE
C. A. & C. RAILROAD RIGHT OF WAY.

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of June, 1927, a petition was filed with the Council signed by all of the owners of the property abutting the part of the street proposed to be vacated to-wit: Plum Street between the west line of Summit Street and the east line of the C. A. & C. Railroad right of way and each and all of said abutting property owners consenting to such vacation, and,

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for; that it will not be detrimental to the general interests and ought to be made.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Westerville, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That Plum Street from the west line of Summit Street to the east line of the C. A. & C. Railroad right of way be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2: That the Clerk of Council is hereby ordered and directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
