

## ORDINANCE NO. 882

TO ACCEPT THE PLAT OF BENJAMIN D. AULT AND  
MILDRED A. AULT SUBDIVIDING LAND IN THE  
VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE, OHIO:

Section 1. That the plat of Benjamin D. Ault and Mildred A. Ault subdividing two (2) acres (Old Lot No. 252) of land in the Village of Westerville, be and the same is hereby approved and accepted.

Section 2. That the Clerk of the Village of Westerville is hereby authorized to so certify said acceptance in said plat.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and the earliest period allowed by law.

Ordinance No. 883

AN ORDINANCE TO ACQUIRE REAL ESTATE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING A PUBLIC PARKING LOT FOR THE INHABITANTS OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to enlarge certain areas provided for public parking grounds;

AND WHEREAS, additional area adjacent to that already possessed by the Village is owned by the Young-Budd Post, No. 171, American Legion, Inc., and

WHEREAS, the Post is willing to sell and convey this property to the Village of Westerville for the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTERVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, more than two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the following described property be, and the same is hereby purchased from the Young-Budd Post, No. 171, American Legion, Inc., and appropriated to public use for a parking lot, as follows, to-wit:

Situated in the Village of Westerville, in the County of Franklin and in the State of Ohio, and more particularly described as follows:

Being a part of Lots 4 and 5 in the original town of Westerville as numbered and delineated upon the recorded plat of said town of record in Deed Book No. 21, pages 264 and 265; Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio.

Beginning at an iron pin in the east line of Knox Street, which iron pin is 111 feet north of the intersection of the east line of Knox Street and the north line of West College Avenue; thence east on a parallel with the north line of West College Avenue, passing an iron pin at 78.55 feet, a distance of 144.60 feet to an iron pin; thence north on a line parallel with the east line of Knox Street; a distance of 59 feet to an iron pin; thence west on a line parallel with the north line of West College Avenue, passing an iron pin at 66.25 feet, a distance of 144.60 feet to an iron pin in the east line of Knox Street; thence south along the east line of Knox Street, a distance of 30 feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2. That the City Manager and Solicitor be and are hereby instructed to prepare the necessary documents and obtain the required signatures to deliver this property to the Village of Westerville, free and clear of all encumbrances.

Section 3. That there is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00) to pay the consideration for this real estate.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
