CHANGING THE NAME OF A PORTION OF OLD MOUND STREET TO ANDRUS AVENUE
IN THE CITY OF WHITEHALL, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDANINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITEHALL, STATE
OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the hereinafter described section of Mound
Street be, and the same hereby is changed in name from Mound Street
to Andrus Avenue as shown in the Pinecrest Addition Plat Book 30,
page 16 and 17.

Situate in the City of Whitehall, Franklin County, Ohio
and being known as Mound Street, 60 feet in width,
extending from the west line of Jaeger Manor Addition to
the west line of Yearling Road, said Jaeger Manor Addition
being shown of record in Plat Book 21, Page 9, Recorder's
Office, Franklin County, Ohio.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
ordinance, necessary for the public health, peace, safety and welfare
of said City, and shall therefore go into immediate effect upon its
passage and approval by the Mayor.
