**AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE AN ALLEY IN THE CITY OF WHITEHALL, OHIO, BETWEEN LOTS NO. 48 AND 56 IN THE BLOWER ADDITION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary to vacate an alley in the City of Whitehall, Ohio, between Lots No. 48 and 56 in the Blower Addition, for the preservation of the health, peace, safety and welfare of the City of Whitehall, and,

WHEREAS, a petition has been duly presented to this Council signed by the property owners of all of the lots abutting upon the following described alley sought to be vacated between Lots No. 48 and 56 in the Blower Addition as per following description:

"Being that portion of a sixteen foot alley between Lots No. 48 and 56 in the blower addition running in an easterly and westerly direction, approximately 200 feet south of East Main Street for a distance of 86.75 feet.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Whitehall, Ohio, upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for the vacation of said alley as described and prayed for in said petition and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interests and should be made;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITEHALL, FRANKLIN COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That an alley between Lots No. 48 and 56 in the Blower Addition extending in a general easterly and westerly direction, as per the following description:

Being that portion of a sixteen foot alley between Lots No. 48 and 56 in the Blower Addition running in an easterly and westerly direction, approximately 200 feet south of East Main Street for a distance of 86.75 feet.

be and the same hereby is vacated.

Section 2. That the City of Whitehall reserves the right to operate and maintain any and all present easements for sewers, water lines, and other public utilities now owned by the City and or installed in the said alley.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be and is, because of the emergency set forth in the preamble, hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
