ORDINANCE NO. M 357-56

CHANGING THE NAME OF A PORTION OF OLD HAMILTON ROAD TO SHUMAKER LANE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITEHALL, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the hereinafter described section of Old Hamilton Road be, and the same hereby is, changed in name from Old Hamilton Road to Shumaker Lane:

Beginning at a point in the east line of Old Hamilton Road, said point being also in the southwest line of Fairway Boulevard, said point being also 104.43 feet (as measured on the southwest line of Fairway Boulevard) northwest of the west line of Hamilton Road; thence northwest with the southwest line of Fairway Boulevard 91.42 feet to the west line of Old Hamilton Road; thence south $3^{\circ} 17'$ west with the west line of Old Hamilton Road 575 feet more or less to the intersection of said west line with the west line of Hamilton Road (50.00 feet west of the centerline); thence northerly with the west line of Hamilton Road 217 feet more or less to the intersection of the west line of Hamilton Road (30.0 feet west of the centerline) and the east line of Old Hamilton Road; thence north $3^{\circ} 17'$ east with the east line of Old Hamilton Road 299.41 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance, necessary for the health, peace, safety and welfare of said City, and shall therefore go into immediate effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

CHANGE OF NAME OF BROADMOOR AVENUE TO THE NAME
OF MAYFLOWER BOULEVARD FROM CHANDLER DRIVE TO
YEARLING ROAD

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WHITEHALL, FRANKLIN
COUNTY, OHIO:

Drive to Yearling Road, be changed to Mayflower Boulevard.
