CHANGING THE NAME OF POTH ROAD FROM THE INTERSECTIONS OF POTH ROAD AND WOODCLIFF DRIVE NORTH TO HAMILTON ROAD TO WOODCLIFF DRIVE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Whitehall presently has two streets which are both called Poth Road; and

WHEREAS, one of these streets runs east and west and the other although considered an extension runs north and south; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Whitehall, Ohio has reported favorably on a change of name under the provisions of R. C. Section 713.02; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITEHALL, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the name of Poth Road extending from the intersection of Poth Road east at the intersection of Woodcliff Drive north to Hamilton Road be and the same is hereby changed to Woodcliff Drive.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk of the Council of the City of Whitehall, Ohio is directed to forward a certified copy of this ordinance to the Postmaster, Columbus, Ohio to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio and to all others who she believes will require this information.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare and for the reasons stated in the preamble and for the further reason that such a change in name should result in less confusion; wherefore, this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
