ORDINANCE NO. 463-57

VACATING THE FIRST ALLEY SOUTH OF, AND PARALLEL TO, MAIN STREET, RUNNING FROM HAMILTON ROAD WEST TO ROSS ROAD, IN THE CITY OF WHITEHALL, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the owners of all of the property abutting on the first alley south of, and parallel to, Main Street, running from Hamilton Road west to Ross Road, have, by proper petition filed with the Clerk of this City, requested the vacation of same, and,

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of Whitehall, Ohio has recommended the approval of said vacation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITEHALL, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the first alley south of, and parallel to, Main Street, running from Hamilton Road west to Ross Road, in the City of Whitehall, Ohio, be, and the same is hereby, vacated.

SECTION 2. That the City of Whitehall specifically reserves in said alley an easement therein, with the right of ingress and egress at all times, in order to place therein, to maintain, repair, operate or otherwise control any and all public utilities, including telephone and electric lines and poles, gas lines, water lines, sanitary sewer lines and storm sewers, which may now be in place in said property, or which may at any time in the future be placed therein.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, the immediate passage of which is necessary for the health, peace, safety and welfare of said community, in that, in order to carry out immediate construction plans concerning the property herein vacated, this Ordinance must go into effect at once upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

CHANGE OF NAME OF BROADMOOR AVENUE TO THE NAME

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WHITEHALL, FRANKLIN COUNTY,
