

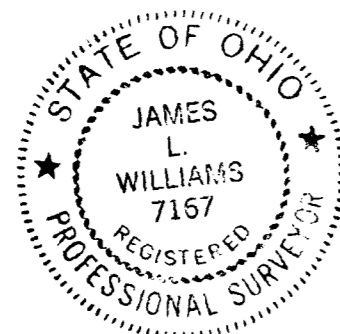

Thence, with the northerly line of said 0.104 Acre tract, North 86 degrees 04 minutes 25 seconds West, 41.10 feet to a found Franklin County Engineer's iron pin, said iron pin being THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING of the following herein described tract;

Thence, with the westerly line of said 0.104 Acre tract, and with a curve to the left whose radius is 1482.39 feet, whose chord bearing is South 08 degrees 10 minutes 35 seconds West, a chord distance of 99.35 feet to a found Franklin County Engineer's iron pin in the northerly line of the Fred and Lorna Lahrmer tract (Deed Book 2848, Page 529);

Thence, with the northerly line of said Lahrmer tract, North 85 degrees 42 minutes 12 seconds West, 177.98 feet to an iron pin;
