On the petition William Badger Saw and count it appearing to the satisfaction of the board that the petition was duly advertised for a road beginning at the pickaway County line and running along the Cut Out road to - John Martins and from fence to William Badger farm thence to John Hiler thence to Nicholas Humphries and thence along the Cut Out road that leads past John Whites to Robert Culbertson along said Culbertson line to land - thence intersect the line between said Culbertson and Thomas Moerheods House thence to the river thence up to John Rausburgs thence along the road from Rausburgs to Franklinton ordered that Lucus Sullivant George Skidmore and Joseph Vance surveyor to meet at the house of Jacob Hitler Esq. one the first Monday in July and being duly sworn proceed to view and report on said road accoring to Law.

The south line of Culbertson was the south line of VMS 422; from the south line of Culbertson, the road went east to the Scioto River, then went up the river to Ransburgh's mill (area of present Greenlawn Avenue) and continued along the river to Franklinton.

Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment present same as yesterday this day John Kerr, William Lang, William Merrin, Samuel Marshall, John Shields, were appointed viewers to assess damage on a road petitioned by William Badger commencing at the Pickaway line running through Robert Culbertson and John Hoffman land thence to Franklinton ordered that the viewers meet at the house of Jacob Heller in Franklinton on the last Friday in January 1817 and after being duly qualified proceeded to review and assess damages according to Law.
