On the pition of Ebenezer Richards for an alteration in a road running through Norwich Township on the East side of the Scioto River Beginning at the spring branch above McCays mill and ending where the two lines come together Thos. Hutchison now ordered that Joseph Gerton, Jacob Grubb and George Skidmore viewers and Joseph Vance Surveyor meet at the House of Daniel Brunks on the third Monday in January 1817 and after being Duly Sworn proceeded to review and make report at our next meeting.

Ordered that the Road pition for by Ebenezer Richards running through Norwich Township beginning at the Spring branch above McCays Mill and end where the two lines come togeather that Hutchison viewed by Joseph Gordon, George Shannon and Jacob Grubb and surveyed by Joseph Vance be open thirty five feet wide and that the same be intered of Record 8C

And it is further ordered that the viewers aforesaid be paid Each the sum hereunder annexed to their names to-wit

Joseph Gordon----- paid June 3, 1817----- \$2.00  
George Skidmore----paid May 3, 1817-----\$2.00  
Jacob Grubb -----paid ----- \$2.00

Where upon the Commissioners adjourned till tomarrow morning 10, Oclock
