Commissioners meet pursuant to adjournment present same as yesterday on the petition of Lucas Sullivan and others for a road to begin in Broadway in Columbus at the East end of Cullivant's Bridge thence on the bridge to the Westerley end thence on a direct line to the east end of the street in Franklinton on which William Domigan lives, thence with said street to Washington street in Franklinton thence with that street in said town.

Ordered that Samuel Davis, Alexander Bassett and Thomas Mickey viewers Joseph Vance Surveyor meet at the house of Jacob Keller in the town of Franklinton on the first Saturday in March 1817 and after being duly qualified as the law Directs proceeded to view said road and make report thereon at the next session of the Commissioners adjourned till tomorrow 10 O'clock

This day the report of the viewers appointed to view and pass Damages on the land of Lucas Sullivant for the damages he sustains in consequence of the opening a road from Main street in Franklinton to Broadway in Columbus which was returned on the first day of this meeting was taken into consideration and after due deliberation it is ordered by the Commissioners that the treasurer pay unto said Sullivant the sum of four hundred and thirty three Dollars the damages assessed to him by said viewers be allowed the sums annexed to their Several names for their services in viewing said ground to-wit

Commissioners meet pursuant to adjournment present same as yesterday, Ordered that the road viewed by Alexander Basset and Thomas Mickey and surveyed by Joseph Vance petitioned for by Lucas Sullivant commencing at the West end of Broad Street in Columbus crossing said Sullivant Bridge thence to Franklinton as ordered of Record and it is further ordered that said road be open not to exceeding fifty feet wide and that trustees of the township through which said road passes be notified of this order.

Ordered that the following persons be paid sum annexed to their names for serving as viewers on the parara road from Columbus to Franklinton to Wit.

Alexander Bassett paid August 22, 1818, One Dollar

Thomas Mickey paid Sept. 14, 1818, One Dollar

Samuel Davis paid One Dollar
