Orded that Samuel Barr, Joseph Huter and Joseph Smart Viewers and Joseph Vance Surveyor meet at the House of Tracy Willcox on the second Saturday in May next, and after being Duly qualified agreeably to law proceed to view said road and make report thereof at our next meeting & C

Where upon the Commissioners adjourned till tomarrow morning at 9 O'clock

On the pition of Chandler Rodger and others for the alteration of a road on the West side of Whetstone River in Sharon Township beginning at a branch of water South of Stevin Maynard and on said Maynard farm whereas the road running from the above mentioned branch to the Northwest corner of said Maynard Garden thence Northwest until it intersects the State road leading from Franklinton to Delaware hath and doth very meaterialy injury the utility of said road we therefore pray you grant - viewers to survey that part of said road Beginning at the above mentioned branch until it intersects the aforesaid State Road by laying a New Road Beginning at the said Branch and running North thirty-degrees West until it Intersects the said State road running from Franklinton to Delaware where upon the Commissioners did appoint Joseph Hunter, Joseph Smart and Samual Barr viewers and Joseph Vance - Surveyor and order them proceed according to Law.

On the Return of a road pition by Joseph Smart and Joseph Hunter and Surveyed by Joseph-Vance pition for by Chandler Rodgers and others commencing near Doctor Steven Maynards at a-point South of said Maynards House to-wit at a sugar tree near a run thence North thirty West ninty two poles to the State road By W.Teller to Delaware being twice read agreeable to Law-ordered to be recorded.

August 21, 1817 and the same to be opened forty feet wide and that the trustees of the Township where said road runs be notified to proceed agreeable to Law.
