Road from the South end of High Street in the town of Columbus to intersect the Chillicothe Road.  
COLUMBUS, MARCH 1st, 1813.

We who's names are hereinto subscribed being appointed by the Commissioners of the County of Franklin to View the ground for a Road to commence at the South end of High Street in said town of Columbus to run thence Southwardly till it may unite with the Chillicothe Road in conformity with the petition of Syne Sterling and others for opening such Road - After having been duly qualified and having carefully Viewed the ground due report that a Road when opened from the South end of High Street in the said town of Columbus, commencing at the Westwardly side of said street and to be opened four poles wide, on the left-hand side of the lines marked by us when proceeding Southwardly will be of general and public Utility when opened. The courses and distances to be as follows,

Commencing at the South end of High Street at the westwardly side of said street thence South twelve degrees East two hundred sixty poles to the new Lancaster old Road, thence five degrees west sixty two poles to a Red Oak at the Easterly side of the Chillicothe Road.
