To the Honorable, the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County,

GENTLEMEN:

We the subscribers being of the opinion that an alteration or a variation of the State Road leading from franklinton to Delaware would be of Public and private advantage.

We therefore pray your honors to take the same under your wise consideration Vis. Beginning where the new County Road commences on the Batabone's Section, thence northerly on said County Road until it comes to the northwest corner of Steven Maynard gardens, from thence north 42 degrees west into the said State Road which distance is 72 rods, which will shorten the travel 25 rods and lie on better ground and is at present in better repair.

Is ordered that the above petition be allowed and that John Wilson, Samuel Henderson & R Stanberry, Viewers, meet at James Cumstock on the 2nd day of April 1815 at 9 o'clock P.M. and proceed to view, layout, and make return according to law.
