FEB. 8, 1817. IN VACATION.

The following returns of a Road was made. The field notes of a State Road commencing at the west end of Broad Street in Columbus, thence S 78 W 190 poles cross Sullivant field 193 poles entered Franklia Street in Franklinton 320 poles 1st mile on the hill west of Franklinton 40 poles the bridge cross the mill race 286 poles, thence south 12 West 126 poles interceted the old State Road from Franklinton to Dayton near a small branch on the west side of a prairie.

We Thomas Bachus and Joseph Muller having been appointed by the leg-islature of the State of Ohio to run out and open a State Road from the west end of Broad Street in Columbus to the east end of Franklin Street in Franklinton & to continue with said Franklin Street to a canal or mill race west of said Franklinton, thence westwardly to intersect the State Road leading from Franklinton to Dayton at or near a small branch, the west side of the prairie which surroundsthe town of Franklinton do make returns to the Commissioners of Franklin County as the above, Tho.
