KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That we, Samuel Ramsey and William Mooberry, are held and firmly bound unto the Treasurer of Franklin County in just an full sum of One Hundred dollars, Payment of which well and truly to be made, We bind ourselves, our heirs, etc, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Witness our hands and seals, the 12th day of March in the year of 1818.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that, Whereas, the above bound Samuel Ramsey hath this day presented a petition to the Commissioners of Franklin County, for a View of a road as follows, Beginning at the south end of William Mooberry's land, thence south along the west line of the line of James Ramsey's land to his southwest corner, thence southwardly the best way to the fording of Big Belly creek on the Lancaster road.

Now if the above bound Samuel Ramsey and William Mooberry, do will and truly pay all cost that may accrue on said road, in case said road fails, then this obligation to be void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force in law.

On the return of a View of a road petitioned by Samuel Ramsey as follows. Viz.

That the unnamed Viewers of a Road from the end of Wm. Moberly's land to the place where the Lancaster road to Columbus crosses Big Belly. Has been duly sworn and we are of opinion that if a road be opened and kept in repair of the following course and distance that will be of Public Utility. Beginning at Moberly's land then due south on the South line of several sections according to the order for 760 poles, thence S 18 W 40 poles, thence S 5 W 140 poles, thence South 39 E 20 poles to the place where the Lancaster road to Columbus crosses Big Belly and we are of opinion that the late laid out road by George Williams, M. Fisher and Wm. Stewart ought to be vacated from said Moberly's unto said crossing of Big Belly. April 11, 1818.
