Know all men by these presents, That we, William McKibben and Samuel Kerr are held and firmly bound unto the Commissioners of Franklin County, in the just and full sum of Two Hundred and Sixty dollars, the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, etc, jointly and severally firmly by these presents. Witness our hands and seals, the 11th day of April in the year of 1818.

The condition of the above obligation is such, That, whereas, the above bound William McKibben hath been appointed by the Commissioners of Franklin County, Road Commissioner on the road leading from Franklinton to Hillsborough, in order for to repair said road, and whereas the Commissioners have appropriated One Hundred and Thirty dollars for said purpose Now if the said William McKibben will well and truly discharge his duties as Road Commissioners; and have said Road repaired against the 1st day of October next, then this obligation to be void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force in law.
