

On the return of a State Road laid out by Patrick McLane agreeable to an appointment made by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio by resolution dated January 20, 1817, Reported as follows:

I have proceeded to lay out a road from Columbus by London to Springfield as follows, Viz:

Beginning at the west end of Broad Street of Columbus on the east bank of the Scioto River, running S 78 W 560 poles crossing the Scioto and passing Franklin Court House Mark 1st mile S 10 W 115 poles mark 2 miles, S 82 W 700 poles, mark 3rd & 4th mile S 38 W 160 poles, S 49 W 300 poles mark the 5th mile, S 36 W 307 poles crossing a branch at 20 poles, Mark the 6th mile S 55 W 500 poles Mark the 7th & 8th mile, S 73 W 505 poles, crosses Darby run at 200 poles mark the 9th mile, S 63 W 425 poles mark the 10th & 11th mile, N 80 W 100 poles, S 52 W 60 poles through the streets of Georgesville N 41 W 28 poles, -crosses main Darby.

S 85 W 40 poles cross little Darby S 44 W 40 poles, mark 12 miles S 79 W 300 poles, S 58 W 180 poles to the line between Franklin and Madison County marking the 13th mile. June 20th, 1817.
