On the petition of John Huffman and others for an evacuation or vacation of the road petitioned for by William Badger, Sen., which road passes John Kiles farm, from thence by Nichols Haughn's house and from thence northerly near John White's farm known by the name of Thomas Moorhead farm, thence by John Ransburgh's Mill to Franklinton to be vacated between the mouth, the land over the banks of the Scioto where cut out south of the banks of same. Whereupon Weoley Conrad and others have presented remains same praying for a Review on said Road, it is therefore ordered that George Skidmore, Rober Eliot and Ebenezer Richards be and they are hereby appointed Reviewers and that they meet at the house of Jacob Keller, Esq., and after being sworn as the law directs, proceed to Review the above mentioned road and make report thereof at the next meeting of the Commissioners of Franklin County, August 14, 1818.

Said Reviewers are to meet on the 11th day of September next.

It is hereby ordered further on hearing the objections of an of the parties against Robert Eliot who has been heretofore appointed one of the Viewers of the aforesaid road and that William Demigan be and he is hereby appointed in the boon of Robert Eliot objected to and that the said William Demigan as in that case before provided, August 19, 1818.
