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ARMSTEAD PETITION

On the petition of William Armstead and others for a road, between Franklinton and S. McLish on the west side of the Scioto river.

Beginning at Hoppers and taking the nearest and best route to the south end of High Street in Dublin thence with said Street to Charles Mitchell.

It is therefore ordered that Adam Brotherton, Joseph Badger, and William Fleming, Viewers, and Ezekial Curtis surveyor on said road and that they meet at the house of Jacob Keller, Esq. on the 7th of November next and after being duly sworn as the law directs proceed to view and survey said road and make report thereof at the next regular meeting of the Commissioners of Franklin County October 31, 1818.

Dublin Road - from the south line of Dublin south 3.4 miles, between Davidson Road and Schirtzinger Road and from the north line of Dublin to the residence of Charles Mitchel, just south of Brand Road

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ARMSTEAD'S ROAD.

Survey of a road according to the order of the County Commissioners on the 16th of November, 1818. Beginning opposite the dwelling house of Wm. Hoppers in Franklin Township, thence N 30 W 32 N 50 W 23 N 40 W 15 N 40 W 80, N 60 W 15 to State Run crossing it a few rods East of the road traveled at the present time, thence N 29 W 14 chains N 14 W 19 N 28 W 103 to the now traveled road Northerly of Robert Elliots, thence N 12 W 15 P. N 6- W 177 P. N 13 W 10 P. N 32 W 15 P. N. 14 W 36 P. N 30 W 21 P. N 15 W 12 P. N 24 W 39 P. N 12 W 20 P. N 4-1/2 E 78 to the south end of High Street in the town of Dublin, thence along said Street N 12 W 20, N 58 E 4 P. N 14 W 2250 po. N 7 W 2250 P. opposite the Dwelling house of Charles Mitchell, E. Curtis- Surveyor.

We the Viewers having been ordered to run the within or above described road by the County Commissioners have met at the day, time, and place, aforesaid by the Commissioners of Franklin County and after being duly sworn according to law have proceeded to View and explore the route above described and others contemplated and after satisfying ourselves confidently report as follows.

That on contemplated routes between Franklinton and Dublin, that we explored expensive digging and bridging must in many places be done, to make a public road that on within the described route, such digging and bridging is generally shunned, that the road is now on the best ground, and best general course, that can be between the above mentioned points, between the said Charles Mitchael and Wm. Hoppers.

It is therefore ordered that the above road be of Record, agreeable to the above described courses and distances, as reported by the above Viewers and that the same be opened sixty feet wide and made in other respects as the law directs, and that the trustees of the several Townships through which said road they runs be notified of this order.
