MAYNARD PETITION FOR A PETITION.

On the petition Steven Maynard and others for an alteration and vacation of the State road leading from Franklinton to Delaware on the west side of Whetstone creek as followeth.

Beginning at a Run south of Steven Maynard, thence Northwardly as the new County road now runs to intersect the old State road near Isaac Fishers, and vacate the old State road between the intersecting points.

Ordered that Horace Walcutt, Thomas Bachus and John Hunter be appointed Viewers, and Ezekial Curtis Surveyor on said road, and that they meet at the house of Steven Maynard Esq. on the seventeenth of June 1819. And after being qualified as the law directs proceed to View said road and make report thereof at the next regular meeting of the Commissioners of Franklin County, June 9th 1819.

Surveyors report of the above road surveyed of a part of the State road leading from Franklinton to Delaware on the west side of Whetstone creek, according to order of the Commissioners of Franklin County as follows,

Beginning at a run Sly of where Steven Maynard now lives, runs thence N 509 P. thence 27 E 30 P. thence N 13 W 42 poles, N 4 E 30 P. N 17 E 32 P. N 158 P. N.15 W 86 P. N 25 E 38 P. N 33 E 36 P. N 5 E 62 P. to a small run S.L.Y. of Wm. Isaac Fisher, distance 1023 P. Equal to 3 miles 63 poles July 2nd 1819.

Remonstrance of Tracey Wilcox and others.

To the Honorable the Commissioners of Franklin County now sitting at Franklinton the Humble Remonstrance of undersigned sheweth to your Honors that they are residents of the neighborhood and vicinity where that part of the State road leading from Franklinton to Delaware is prayed to be altered by a certain petition submitted to your Honorable body and dated May 1, 1819, signed by Steven Maynard and others-- that several of the undersigned live on that part of the State road, which said petition prays to have vacated and would be extremely injured and almost shut up, from any direct communication with Franklinton or Delaware, and as the undersigned believes the Public would receive no benefit from the prayer of said petition being granted, the undersigned do therefore wholly remonstrate against the prayer of said petition being granted and beg your Honor to appoint Viewers to go on and Review said road and make report according to law. Ordered that John Shields, John Kerr, Robert Nelson, Samuel Davis and Daniel Brunk be and they are hereby appointed Reviewers and that they meet at the house of Steven Maynard Esq. on Monday the sixteenth day of this instance and after being qualified as the law directs, proceed to Review the afore mentioned road, and make report thereof at the next

Return of a Review on remonstrance of Tracey Wilcox and others.

The undersigned Reviewers appointed by the within order to Review the old State road from the run South of Steven Maynard Esq. northwardly to its points of union with the now County road, south wardly from & near to Isaac Fishers, having met at the house of Steven Maynard and being duly qualified as the order within requires they proceeded to View the new County road and also the old State road between Steven Maynard and Isaac Fishers, the points mentioned in the petition praying for the vacation of part of the old State road after the Review. They having maturely examined the subject of their appointment. They report that it is reasonable and proper and for the Public Utility that the prayer of the petitioners for vacating part of the old State road shall not been granted, but that both roads shall remain open and free for Public use. Given under our hands and seals this 16th day of August 1819.
