On the petition of William Kitzmilller for a road up the west side of Black Lick creek as follows-
Beginning at an established road at or near Headley's Mill in Jefferson Township and running on the
west side of Black Lick creek, by Asa Whitehead, Joseph Scotts, David Smiths & Daniel Smiths, thence
across said creek between Daniel Smiths and William Kitzmilller on the nearest and best ground to
the County line and to intersect at an established road in Licking County called the Coschoton Road.

Ordered that Robert Nelson, John Luke and David Pugh be appointed Viewers on said road and --
Steven R. Price surveyor and that they meet at the house of Jacob Smith, Esq., on Thursday the 9th
day of August 1819, and after being qualified as the law directs proceed to View and survey said
road and make report thereof at the next regular meeting of the Commissioners of Franklin County.

On the return of a view and Survey of a road as follows.

August 19, 1819. Agreeable to an order of the Commissioners of Franklin County at there August Session 1819 to us directed to view and survey a road. Beginning near Headley's Mill on Black Lick thence up the west side of said creek to meet the Coshoton road at the County line and after being duly sworn proceeded and Surveyed said road of which the Annexed Plat is a true representation.

Beginning near Headley's Mill as aforesaid at the termination of a late new laid off road from the Turnpike road near Alum Creek passing Andrew S. Smileys and Elexander's Mill to near Headley's Mill aforesaid, thence up the west side of Black Lick N 11 E 41 P., thence N 5 E 31 P., thence N 15 E 14 P., N 29-1/2 E 37 P., N 60 E 36 P. passing Elyat Freemans N 22 E 48 P., to the Township line, thence N 16-1/2, E 88 P. passing Asa Whiteheads at 20 poles, thence N 28-1/2 E 26 P. to the first mile tree thence the same course 16 poles, N 23 E 94 P., passing Joseph Scotts at 60 P., thence N 15 E 76 P. to Daniel Noe's, thence N 6 E 37 po. N 25 E 100 P. to the second mile tree, thence N 72 E 120 P. N 15 E 174 P., passing the Granville road at 22 P. N.E. 26 P. to three mile tree, thence N 36 E 114 P. thence N 5 E 70 P., thence N 15 E 48 P. thence N 5 E 32 P., thence N 9 E 56 P. to fourth mile at David Smiths, thence same course 36 P. to Henry Smiths, thence N 3 E 82 to John Smiths N 27 E 26 P. to grave yard, N 28-1/2 E 106 to Daniel Smiths N 20-1/2 E 66 P. to the fifth mile thence the same course 30 P. N 1 W 50 to William Kitzmillers, thence N 40 E 108 P. N 31 E 18 P., N 62-1/2 E 83 P. meeting the Coschoton road passing through John Lours at the County line.

REPORT OF VIEWERS ON THE ABOVE ROAD

It is our opinion that the said road is very nesacary and will be of considerable Public Utility as there is no road in the northeast direction to the County line that direction and as they have opened the road to the County line in hope of it being continued to Columbus and said road likewise is on very good ground generally.
