On the petition for an alteration of part of the State road on the west side of Whetstone by Thomas Moor on his own land as follows, Beginning a few poles south of a green Buckeye stump on the west bank of the thoroughfare, thence up the west bank of the Whetstone creek, until the same strikes the land of Joseph Hunter and to vacate so much of the old road as lay between these two intersecting points.

Ordered that John Shields, Michael Patton and John Brickel be appointed Viewers for said road, and that they meet at the house of Eli C. King on Wednesday the 11th instant and after being qualified as the law directs proceed to View and measure said road and make report thereof at the next regular meeting of the Commissioners of Franklin County August 4, 1819.

On the return of the Viewers of an alteration of a road on Thos. Moor's land, we the subscribers, have on the 11th day of August 1819 after being duly sworn, have Viewed a road agreeable to an order given to Thomas Moor and on measuring the same, both old and new road find the new road to be 20 feet longer then the old one and on much better ground and are of opinion the vacation of the old road and the establishing of the new will be no injury to the Public, but of Public Utility, Given under our hands this 11th day of August 1819.

The Commissioners being fully satisfied that the new part of the road is in as good order as the old part was previous to the operation. It is therefore ordered that so much of the old part as petitioned for by said Moor be henceforth vacated, and the new part be of Record and considered as a Public highway.
