ZAKERIAH PAUL & JOHN HOUSE PETITION

On the petition of Zakeriah Paul and others for a road and vacation of part of a road as follows: Commencing at near the Widow Lambert so as to intersect the road leading to Columbus on the east side of Big Walnut Creek and running east up the said creek on the same ground where the road is now worked running by Emmor Cox, Esq., thence by Thomas Woods and to continue on the same ground that is now worked for the road by John Long, Esq. from thence to John Hanson's north line so as to intersect the road leading to See's mill. Your humble petitioners also praying that you would vacate that much of the old Bixby Road.

It is therefore ordered that William Caldwell, George Hays, and Robert Taylor be and they are hereby appointed viewers on said road and William Stewart, Surveyor, and that they meet at the house of Emor Cox, Esq. on the 12th day of December next and after being qualified as the law directs proceed to view and survey said road and make report thereof at the next regular meeting of the Commissioners of Franklin County November 15, 1819.
