On the petition of William Headley for an alteration of a road on his own land at his own expense which road was located by Steven R. Price, Surveyor & viewed by David Pugh & Robert Nelson, some time in 1819.

Ordered that Michael Stagg, Senior, John H. Smith and William Carr be appointed viewers on said road and that they meet at the house of Jacob Smith on or before the 24th day of this Instant and after being qualified, view said road and make report thereof at the next regular meeting of the Commissioners of Franklin County June 15th, 1820.

WILLIAM HEADLEY ROAD

On the return of viewers on William Headley's road for an alteration on his own land as follows. Beginning where Steven R. Price intersected the road that was surveyed by A. V. Taylor from Headley's Mill running east 17 degrees North 34 poles, thence North 117 poles to the end of Eligiah Frenan's land on William Headleys line and then beginning on the line between Headleys and Freemans where Steven R. Price crossed said line and then following Prices survey to the place of beginning and find the old survey to be 124 poles and we do conceive the new survey to be of more Public Utility and on better ground Oct. 13, 1820.

It is therefore ordered that the above road be henceforth of Record according to the above laid down courses and distances and that, that part of the road surveyed by Steven R. Price between the intersecting points of the above alteration be henceforth vacated as null and void and that said new part be opened sixty feet wide and made in other respects as the law directs and that the Trustees in the Township said alteration lies be notified of this order.
