 TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY:

The petition of the undersigned humbly represents that they concieve it would conduce to the Public convenience if a road was established agreeable to the following boundaries, to wit: Beginning at the North line of Plain Township at the end of the County road near the Northeast corner of Section No. 4 and running a straight course to the Bridge on Rocky Fork at David Wrights and from thence the nearest and best way to intersect the County road at Headley's Mill on Black Lick the Petitioners having complied with the law.

It is therefore ordered that John H. Smith, Wm. Smith and William Kitzmiller be appointed viewers, and Timothy Lee - Surveyor on said road and that they meet at David Wrights on the 9th day of June next and after being qualified as the law directs and proceed to view and survey said road and make report thereof at the next regular meeting of the Commissioners of Franklin County.

JOHN DAVIS ROAD

On the return of viewers of a road petitioned for by John Davis and others. Agreeable to the within order for a survey of a road near David Wrights to Headley's Mill under the direction of William Kitzmiller and John H. Smith as viewers. A location and survey was made and on the 9th and 10th of June 1820 of which the subjoined is a correct return.

Beginning at the North line of Plain Township at end of the County road near the Southeast corner of Section four running South 37 W 66 poles, thence S 34 E 466 P. S 224 P. S 17 E 76 P. S 40 E 72 Po. S 20 E 96, S 98 poles, S 7 W 217 poles, S 26 E 38 po. S 12 W 160 P. S 20 E 120 P. S 10 E 230 poles to the County road at Headley's Mill on Black Lick being five miles and 273 poles on a scale of 200 poles to an inch.

In pursuance to an order to an orderto us directed we have viewed the ground for a road to be laid from the County line near David Wrights to Headley's Mill and having attended to the surveying of it would report favorably for the opening of the same considering that it would be not only of considerable private convenience but of great Public Utility. On the petition of John Long, Zakariah Paul and others for a County road as follows.

Commencing at the County line at or near the Northeast corner of Jacob Reese's land, near Road's saw mill and crossing Black Lick creek at some suitable ford, thence running in a Northwestward direction on the best ground without injuring any improvements passing between the two Pauls to the Bixby road near Robert Longs, thence crossing at the rord between John Longs and Robert Taylors and intersecting of the County road leading to Columbus at the North line of the said Taylor's land.

Ordered that Edward Livingston, William Shaw & Robert Nelson be appointed viewers and Carrington Serles- Surveyor on said road and that they meet a the house of John Long, Esq. on the 9th day of June at 9 o'clock all, on said day and after being qualified as the law directs proceed to view and survey said road and make report thereof at next regular meeting of the Com. of Franklin County March 24, 1820.
