On the Petition John Coons and others for a road, Beginning at the County line at a school house near to Wm. Macrays in the road leading from Jacksonville to Delaware from the County line in the road that is now cut out to Thomas Palmer and Benjimen Chandler's Mill, thence the nearest and best ground to intersect the Turnpike road leading from Columbus to Newark on the East bank of Black Lick creek so as to intersect a road that comes from Delaware as near as possible.

Ordered that John Ranson, William Coswell and Zakiriah Faul be and they are hereby appointed Viewers and Abiather V. Taylor Surveyor on said road and that they meet at the house of John Long, Esq., on the 10th day of April next and be qualified as the law directs and proceed to view and survey said route and make report thereof to the Commissioners OF said County Franklin at their next regular meeting, March 7, 1821.
