



west with said line to the northwest corner of Philip Mooper's land, thence South to the east end of Zakiriah Stepheson lane and thence with said lane to intersect the State road at the crossing of Black Lick creek.

Ordered that John Hanson, Zakiriah Paul & William Cornwell, be and they are hereby appointed - viewers on said road, and that Abiather V. Taylor- Surveyor- and that they meet at the house of John Long, Esq., in Truro Township on the 16th day of August next at 8 o'clock A.M. and after being qualified as the law directs, to proceed to view and survey said road, and make report to the Commissioners of Franklin County at their next meeting Franklinton June 4, 1822.

On the return of a road petitioned for by Joseph Shannon and others-- John Manpers William Cornwell & Zakiriah Paul Viewers and Abiather V. Taylor- Surveyor, agreeably to an order of the Commissioners of Franklin County as follows, Viz.--

Beginning at the County line at the west end of the Jacksonville road and running -- N 47 W 20, rods, thence W 62 rods- thence--N 35 W 110 R. to A. J. Simmons line thence N 15 rods- thence N 73 W 86 R. thence S 85 W 36 R. thence South 74 W 12 R. to 1 mile stake in P. Kings lane- thence--S 74 W 38 R. to Philip King's house, thence South 20 W 8 R. thence W 160 rods- thence S 81 W 18 R. to Algin's corner-- thence W 96 R. - to 2 mile tree, thence W 64 R. thence S 36 rods to the east end of Zakiriah Stepheson lane, thence W 94 R. thence S 48 W 76 R. to the old State road at Black Lick creek crossing.

Ordered that the above road be 40 feet wide & according to law.
