On the petition of William H. Richardson and others praying for the establishment of a road leading from the Lancaster, Columbus road on the land of William H. Richardson in Section twenty seven and thence a southern direction towards Deckard's Mills on Walnut creek -- Beginning in said Lancaster road near a gate Section twenty seven on land of said Richardson, thence to the fording of Walnut near Jacob Ganders -- thence through his lane to the land of Christian Sarber, striking the bank near the bottom of DeLong's run - thence along said bank to said Sarbers east line, thence due South to the Pickaway County line, as near as the ground may admit.

Ordered that William D. Hendron, Emmer Cox & Robert Wilson - be and they are hereby appointed viewers of said road, and that John Sharp be Surveyor- and that they meet at the house of William Godman, Esq., on the fifteenth day of August next at 8 o'clock A. M. and after being qualified as the law directs, do proceed to view and survey said road and make report to the Commissioners of Franklin County at their next meeting.

On the return of a road Petitioned for by William H. Richardson & others- Emmer Cox, William D. Hendron, Robert Wilson, Viewers, & John Sharp, Surveyor, agreeably to and order of the Commissioners of Franklin County- as follows-- Beginning in the Public road leading from Columbus to Lancaster in Section 27 near William H. Richardson's gate, from thence S 13 -1/2 W 34 poles, thence S 6 W 16 poles THENCE S 24 W 12 poles to Walnut creek near Jacob Gander's house, thence S 53 E 12 poles, thence through said Gander's lane S 12 W 24 poles, thence S 37- 1/2 E 18 poles leaving said Gander's lane,

thence S 46 E 52 poles, thence S 19-1/2 E 64 poles and passing part of the distance along on the upland bank near the bottom of DeLong's run - thence with said bank S 55 E 40 poles, thence leaving said bank and running Coincidentally-- with the quarter section line allowing the variation Viz. South 3/4 E 48 poles to the 1 mile tree, thence the same course 188 poles, thence S 20 E 33 poles, thence with the quarter section line again S 3/4 E 99 poles to the 2 mile tree, thence the same course 317 poles, thence S 37 W 3 poles to the three mile tree, thence the same course 13 poles, thence S 37 E 16 poles - ceasing nearly a half mile round the three mile pond, thence S 3/4 E 43 poles, thence S 1 W 28 poles - thence South 28, thence 38 E 24 poles, thence S 1-1/2 E 64 poles to the line of Pickaway County at a distance of 216 poles from the 3 mile tree.

Ordered that the above road be 35 feet wide and according to law.

Ordered to be recorded December 3rd, 1822.
