On the Petition of John Kenney and others for a road beginning at the Southeast corner of John McElvain's improvement on the County road leading from Whetstone to McCoy's Mill thence Northwardly east of Samuel Henderson and East of Baltzer Hesse's improvement then Northwardly on the nearest and best direction to the old fording place of Rathbone's run where the old former road leading from Delaware to Franklinton crosses said run thence Northwardly eighty rods West of the East line of Perry Township thence Northwardly to John Panzham's North line thence Northwardly until it intersects the State Road leading from Franklinton to Delaware at or near Jesse Andrews.

Ordered that Thomas Bull, John Smith, Joseph Hunter, Jr. be appointed viewers and Rodney Rock - Surveyor on said road and that they meet at the house of John Hunter, Esq., on the 14th day of March 1823.

On the return of a road Petitioned for by John Kenny and others the following field notes.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of John McElvain's farm in the road leading from Whetstone to McCoy's mill thence North with his line 114 poles to his corner, thence N 23°-E through Samuel Henderson land 53-1/2 poles to the S.E. corner of his field, thence with his line North 60 poles to the N. E. corner of his field, thence continued North, with his & Mitchel's line in all 130 poles to Mitchel's North corner, thence N 22°-15 W 154- 1/4 poles to a Beech corner to B & D. Hess. Thence N 7°-W 100 poles to a Black Thorn Post N.W. of R. Coi's house, thence N 37°-15 W 397-1/2 poles to a post west of John Kenny's improvement, thence North 555 poles crossing Rathbone's run at the old fording to a post at the corner of John Pangbourn's clearing, thence N 18°- E 308 poles, crossing two small branches to a post in the road leading from Franklinton to Delaware about 2 poles East of Jesse Andrew's house, we the viewers are unanimously of opinion that said road when opened will be of great Public Utility. All of which is respectfully submitted.
