

ON THE RETURN OF A STATE ROAD FROM WORTHINGTON TO NEW HAVEN

Worthington. Tuesday May 9th, 1820. Commenced Survey of State road from Worthington Franklin County Via Salt Section to New Haven in Huron County. Luther Coe & James Kilbourn Commissioners, M. Mathews-Surveyor.

Beginning at N end on Main Street, Worthington, thence N at 1<sup>m</sup> marked post to 1<sup>m</sup> 310 poles, thence 28<sup>o</sup> - E at 2 & 3 M. marked part cont. at 3<sup>m</sup> 50 poles Delaware County line.

It is therefore ordered that the foregoing road be henceforth of Record agreeable the courses laid down and that it be opened agreeable to law.
