On the Petition of Thomas Palmer and others for a road as follows. beginning at Palmers & Cochran's Mill on Black Lick in Truro Township and running from there in a straight line on as near as the land will admit to the East bank of said Black Lick where the road crosses it leading from Columbus to Newark in Jefferson Township and we pray that the road now laid between the two given points may be vacated as being a Public nuisance.

Ordered that David Pugh, John Edgar & Isaac Johnson be and they are hereby appointed viewers and Abiather V. Taylor, Surveyor, on said road and that they meet at Mathew Crofford, Esq., on the 15th day of this Instant and after being qualified as the law directs proceed to view and survey said road and make report thereof at the next meeting of the Commissioners of this County.

I certify the following to be the survey of a road made under the order of the Commissioners of Franklin County bearing date March 3rd, 1824, on the petition of Thomas Palmer and David Pugh, John Edgar & Isaac Johnson, viewers.

Commencing at Palmer's Mill thence N 21 W one mile 120 rods thence North 70 rods to the Turnpike road at the crossing of Black Lick. April 10th, 1824. Paid. A. V. TAYLOR - Surveyor.

I do hereby certify that David Pugh, John Edgar and Isaac Johnson, viewers, and A.V. Taylor - Surveyor - appeared before me and was severally sworn agreeable to the written order.
