LEE TIMOTHY ROAD PETITION by SCOTTS PLAINS TO THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF FRANKLIN GREETING--

We the subscribers land holders and residence in the said County thinking a public Road through the Townships of Harrison & plain in said County to begin on the County road at the Still house of Nash and Gillaspie in said Township of Harrison Thence running along the West Bank of the Big walnut Creek by Lewis Mills crossing said Creek below the dam- Thence the straightest and best course to the north west corner of John Cabbage's land- thence between the farms of Francis Climer and John Cabbage to the south east corner of Francis Climer Land- thence a north-easterly direction to intersect the road leading from Scotts to Duncan Plains near the line between the Counties of Delaware and Franklin and the to end is necessary and if established would conductive to public utility and convenience to hereby respectfully to and request of the said Commissioners to appoint viewers to view the ground along which said Road is proposed to be improvement to the statue in such case made and provided October 7th. 1824- Signers Names

Field notes of a road Commencing at the still house, of Hash and Gillespie in Harrison Township thence East 16. poles thence north 55. East 30. poles North 73. poles East 80- poles North 72 poles East 287. poles South 70 poles East 110 poles South 65. East 30 poles south 80. East 110 poles North 52. East 57 poles to one mile tree North 52. East 170 poles North 30. East 150 poles to 2 miles tree same course 236 poles East 80 poles North 21. East 71 to both trees same course 236 poles out to road leading from Scott's to Duncans plains surveyed Dec. 29th. 1824.

We the undersigned owners were appointed on the above rout for a road having attended to the location of the same agreeable to an order of the Commissioners of Franklin County, do report favorable for the establishing the opening of the same believing it will be of considerable public utility to the Commissioners of Franklin County.

Its thereupon ordered that said road be henceforth of record agreeable to the above laid down courses and distances and that the same be opened 60. feet wide and made in other respect as law directs and that the trustees through whose Township road runs be notified by this order.
