Pursuant to the order of the County Commissioners hereunto attached after being duly Sworn as thereon Stated I proceeded under the direction of the Viewers mentioned in said order to survey and measure the road as hereon protracted. Beginning at the south end of Front Street of the Town of Worthington running from thence south 14 Poles thence S. 13° W. 7 poles, west 15 poles crossing
 P.31. Whetstone Creek N. 17 W. 4 poles 16 links West 146 poles 5 links to center of the County Road at Wilcoxes Corner, thence south with County Road south 248 poles, S. 45 W. 120 poles to Fangbourns road thence S. 18 W. with said road 209 poles South passing Shattucks and Brickets 540 poles to 3 Beach near Kenney's field, thence S. 31 W. 635 poles to large White Oak S. 52° 30" W. 254½ to cross River at McCoy's Mill to a post on west bank, thence S. 10 E. 90 poles S. 21 E. 206 poles to center of County Road near J. Foley's, thence S. 22° 3" W. 1030½ poles to center State Road opposite the end of the Georgesville Road near the Tavern kept by L. Higgins Junior, thence with the Georgesville road except straightening short angles S. 14 W. 91 poles to Hickory S. 23 W. 186 poles S. 18 W. 87 poles in Neff's line S. 9 W. 56 poles S. 27 W. 24 poles S. 3 E. 56½ poles to a point opposite G.
